

Exploration aimed at collecting data on mulberry trees within the territory through the cataloging of the plants and their characteristics.




These activities are necessary to develop the knowledge bank for the benefit of the European Silk Innovation Ecosystem

Teachers should prepare releases, bookings, tickets and guide fees if needed.




Cultural heritage Phase 2 Field Research



Division of students into groups of 4 or 5 people



Identifying a primary topic for each group



Assignment of roles within the group



Deciding on the activity schedule for each group.



Development of materials in the native language and in English (texts, media, etc.)





Field research

To find mulberry trees, students must explore the area on their own.

If necessary, teachers should prepare the relevant waivers and authorizations.



Phase 2 Field Research

Monitoring


During the research phase, it is essential for teachers to monitor the students' source selection and data processing activities, as well as ensure the correct entry of data into the mulberry app



Phase 2 Field Research

Backstage

Students and teachers should record the activity with pictures or behind-the-scenes videos of the different educational phases.
