GUIDELINES FOR UPLOADING PHOTOS IN THE MORUS APP

GUIDELINES

01

Maximum photo size: 7MB.

To resize image you can use: the website <https://compressjpeg.com/> ; the device editor or any photo editor.

02

Avoid using wide-angle lenses for photos as they tend to distort the actual size or shape of the subject.

03

Try to photograph the entire tree without people, cars, or distracting elements covering the view.

04

Do not photograph the tree against the light

Try to have the sun behind you while taking the shot

GUIDELINES

05

Photograph in lighting conditions that allow for accurate colour representation.
no photos with low light, no photos with coloured lights

06

Collect multiple leaves from different points on the tree, including the stems
Select leaves with the most recurring shapes.

07

Place the leaves on a uniform and flat surface
(a white sheet of paper) and position a 5-cent coin next to the leaves to provide a size reference.

08

Photograph by placing the lens perpendicular to the sheet to minimize perspective distortions as much as possible.

GUIDELINES

09

Follow the same procedure from point 7 for photographing fruits. Do not detach the peduncle from the fruit.

10

Select a representative sample of fruits
3 or 4 mulberries from different points on the plant.

11

Arrange the fruits on a uniform surface (a sheet of paper) with a 5-cent coin

12

Do not photograph people's faces
